Biographical Information

Unfortunately, there is no readily available information about the early life or death of Robert G. Balcomb. He first appeared in the1885 Denver City Directory, identified only as a carpenter. By March 1886, Balcomb formed a partnership with Cornell University graduate, Eugene Remich Rice. The newly formed firm of Balcomb and Rice opened their first office in the now demolished Tabor Block at 16th and Larimer Streets. The firm went on to design some of Denver's most elaborate examples of the Queen Anne style that still stand today. The Flower-Vaile House at 1610 Emerson St., the Bouvier-Lathrop House at 1600 Emerson St., the John S. Flower House at 1618 Ogden St., and the Dragon House at 1542 Williams St., are all examples of Balcomb and Rice's exuberant interpretation of the Queen Anne style. The first three are listed in the National Register of Historic Places and the last in the locally designated Wyman Historic District.

The firm's prosperity extended beyond the residential market to include a wide variety of buildings and structures throughout the city. The Denver Building Permit records credit the firm with a church addition, stores, terraces, barns, stables and grand stands. Regrettably, only the residential designs are currently identified in the list below.

The partnership of Balcomb and Rice continued until 1897, when Rice went into business for himself. It is unknown what happened to Balcomb after the partnership dissolved.
